Missionaries to New Zealand

an excerpt from a recent prayer letter....

We have been in communication with two Filipinos in New Zealand. One lady who immigrated there several years ago out of our ministry in Iloilo was glad when she saw on our website that we are coming to New Zealand and is eager to help us when we get there. She told us that some had suggested that she leave New Zealand but she didn't feel led to and now she knows why, and that is to help us when we get there. She still doesn't have a church home in New Zealand and has so many others there that she knows from the Philippines and Asia who are in the same predicament.

Another man in New Zealand is also still without a church. He had this to say to us in an e-mail... *"I hope and pray that the Lord will speed up your way in coming here. I believe that this place desperately needs a good missionary like you and your family."* He then goes on and talks about his struggles in finding missionaries and churches there that are struggling. And then he says... *"To be honest I've been starving spiritually since I arrived. And also concerned where to bring my family when they come. May the Lord bless your way and bring you here without any delay. I know that He hears the cries of the dying souls as well as His children here in New Zealand."* To that I could only say to him to pray, pray and pray, because very few churches in America right now are taking on missionaries.
